February starts with the festival of the Presentation of Christ in the Temple. The number of weeks between this festival and the start of Lent varies from year to year depending on the date of Easter. This year it is the longest possible with four Sundays in the gap before Ash Wednesday.

At the Presentation the infant Jesus is met by two people who have been waiting for him knowing the promise of the coming of the Messiah. Simeon had been told that he would see the Messiah

before he died. The other person is Anna who at eighty four waits for that Messiah. They had waited patiently to meet the Messiah and now both recognise him and rejoice.

The readings on the following Sundays help us to get to know Jesus as he calls his disciples, gives the famous Sermon on the Mount and calms the storm. For those involved it was a time of great change.

We will be going through change as Barbara retires. We rejoice and give thanks for her ministry to us. May we turn to Jesus to guide us through the changes ahead.
